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The later years

After nearly twenty years, with some limited breaks, from 1944 to 1964, Thompson left the world of music. He spent his postwar years in England, and then, from 1947 to 1950, in France. In 1950, under the name William Thompson, he married Helene, whom he met during his travels, and he remained with her until his death. Thompson spent his years in France writing music, but he also made a few recordings. His most famous work is *Concerto for Piano and Orchestra*, which he wrote in 1951. It is a beautiful work, and it is one of the few recordings of his that have been made. He also wrote a number of other works, but they are not as well known. Thompson died in 1964, at the age of 50, of a heart attack.
